- Development of an overall training program; incorporating skill models, offensive and defensive systems, strength and conditioning and individual expectations in regards to the men's program as a whole.
- Attend and run scheduled volleyball training sessions and program activities
- Chair of selection committee with individual team coaches
- Game day coaching of the Men's Premier Division team competing in the 2012 Crazy John's Victorian Volleyball League Season
- Attendance of other Falcons men's and under 17 division games as required.
- Management and mentoring of other coaches within the program
- Enforcement of club policies regarding financial responsibilities and acceptable behaviors.
